### EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 38th MEETING OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL HELD ON MARCH 1, 2019

## ITEM NO. 11 REVIEW AND REVISION OF CLINICAL COURSES FOR B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) AT NALSAR

The Academic Council considered the report submitted by the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor to suggest measures for improving the Legal Aid Clinics of the University and recommended to the Executive Council for its approval for implementation from the academic year 2019 – 2020.

Prof. Ved Kumari suggested that the University should develop the parameters for evaluation of the proposed elective clinics as the students work outside the supervision of the teacher like paralegals. She further suggested that the University may have collaboration with State Legal Services Authority and NGOs to allot work to the students under the Clinics. University may also think of having Start-up for Entrepreneurs as one of the practical Clinic. The works undertaken by the students under the clinics should be pro bono.

Prof. Ved Kumari also suggested that the University may conduct Faculty Development Programme to improve the skills of the Faculty for teaching the clinical courses. The Vice-Chancellor requested Prof. Ved Kumari to conduct a short duration Faculty Development Programme to have conversations with the Faculty Members teaching / willing to teach clinical courses. Prof. Ved Kumari accepted the invitation and agreed to conduct the FDP for the Faculty Members at NALSAR.
