


BRIEF DESCRIPTION ON COURSE (MAXIMUM 500 WORDS)	<p>Focused on India as the location of enquiry, this elective course is being offered against the backdrop of a deepening crisis in legal system across the globe today. Whereas the links between law and justice, or even law and order, have always been far from straightforward, it would not be inaccurate to say that today the world is witnessing a particularly alarming sense of disappointment and cynicism in legal and judicial processes, and in extreme cases their complete abandonment – in the most recent memory in India: the #MeToo movement, the aftermath of Sabarimala temple entry judgment and in longer term, the persistence of naxalism and terrorism are some of the most visible recent examples. Less visible but equally pressing are issues around legal enforceability and justiciability of economic-social rights (ESRs) such as health, employment, education, housing, food and water – these are some of the most politically charged issues of our times. Also, on the one hand, 'strong' governments being elected by the majoritarian voters are drastically changing entire laws to egregiously privilege the powerful, on the other hand in the garb of strong governments, private interests, especially corporations, are systematically undermining power and role of the state as law maker and implementer. Increasingly even the relevance of law and legal remedies in their conventional sense are being questioned in some of the most pressing areas of our lives, such as climate change, and business and human rights. And globalization is challenging state sovereignty and territoriality, the conventional principles of legal systems, in the face of inherently transnational issues such as environment, refugee crisis and trans-border terrorism.</p> <p>The course treats this moment as a pause point for the legal profession as well – some even think it is a crisis point for the legal profession, but there are also some fresh opportunities with accompanying challenges. At the very least, to stay relevant and responsive, the times we are in the midst of entrust us with a new set of responsibilities as well as offer us an opportunity to take stock and reimagine our role as lawyers; indeed that is closely linked with the task of reimagining the world also. 	step back and collates, revisits and examines some of the key sites and processes of law's formation, performance and impacts, as also law itself as a site and process beyond strictly legal, from the Indian context. It builds on our understanding of jurisprudence and professional ethics, but goes beyond them to explore more practice-oriented aspects. The course by no means expects to arrive at any definitive 'solutions' to the problems. This is a less ambitious attempt in the nature of exploration – it leans on illustrative case-studies and undertakes a reflective process, towards provoking an altered consciousness and sensibility on lawyering. Those in turn could possibly inform our future strategies and nudge our practices. This would necessarily be an inside-outside exploration as lawyers, through collaborative thinking and openness to new and emerging ideas from the field.
