

FACULTY MENTORING TO STUDENTS ON ACADEMIC AND OTHER RELATED ISSUES

In addition to the mentoring and guidance provided to the students in academic related issues like writing the projects in each subject, dissertation, seminar papers etc., the University has unique mentoring system in place.

Faculty Mentoring for all the students of First & Second Year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.)

Faculty Members are identified as Mentors for the First & Second year students who conduct periodic sessions on some basic issues and topics that are helpful for the students in building their basics.

Allotment of Faculty Mentors for MBA and BBA, MBA Students

All the students enrolled for the MBA Programme are allotted in groups to the Faculty Members as Mentors to analyse their performance, to discuss the issues faced by the students, to provide guidance on academic matters, internships, placements etc. The Circulars, details of the mentoring provided along with the reports are enclosed herewith.

Teaching Assistantship Programme

The University has Teaching Assistantship programme wherein the students of 5th Year of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) and LL.M. are selected through a rigorous process as Teaching Assistants to conduct tutorials for all the subjects offered in 1st, 2nd & 3rd year B.A., LL.B. (Hons.). The selected Teaching Assistants are mentored by the respective subject Faculty Member for conduct of tutorials. The list of Faculty Members and the list of mentees (Teaching Assistants) is given below. The Teaching Assistants are assessed by the concerned Faculty Members and grade is awarded on the basis of their performance which is considered for three credits and reflected in their transcripts. Further, one Faculty Member is In-Charge of the TA Ship programme.

Moot Mentorship Programme

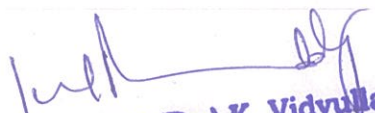
The students of 4th & 5th year, who have experience in mooting are selected through a selection process as Moot Mentors to provide guidance and to prepare the First Year students for the moots. The Moot Mentors are mentored by one Faculty Member who is in-charge of the programme. Their performance is also evaluated by the Faculty Mentor for award of grade which will be counted for three credits in their academic record.

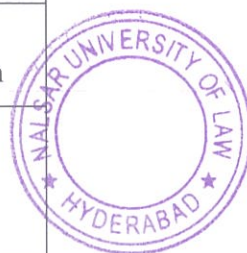
