REGULATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT OF TEACHERS AND LIBRARIAN OF THE ACADEMY

Reg. App. T 5.01

Faculty of the University shall comprise:

- 1. Professors
- 2. Associate Professors
- 3. Assistant Professors
- 4. Teacher Assistants

The Executive Council shall have power to modify these categories from time to time and prescribe their functions as recommended by the University Grants Commission.

Note:

The Director may himself with the approval of the President appoint on contract basis for a period not exceeding three years teacher/teacher assistants or officers and assign such teaching/research responsibility as may be determined by him on the advice of the Faculty.

The Executive Council shall have the power to decide from time to time after considering the recommendations of the Academic Council, the subjects and the number for which Professorships, Associate Professorships, Assistant Professorships and other teaching posts may be instituted.

The Executive Council may, in special circumstances, appoint an eminent person as a teacher on contract for a period not exceeding three years, with a provision of renewal for further period, provided that every such appointment and the terms thereof shall be subject to the prior approval of the President. However, in case of immediate necessity the Director may in exercise of his power under Section 17 of the Ordinance appoint a teacher after approval of the President. Such appointments must be approved in the succeeding meeting of the Executive Council. The duration, terms and conditions shall be determined by the Executive Council.

The Selection Committee shall consist of the following:

- a) The Director who shall be the Chairman of the Committee.
- b) A member of the Executive Council nominated by the President.
- c) A member of the Academic Council nominated by Executive Council.
- d) Expert or experts not more than two nominated by the Director from amongst a panel of names recommended by the Academic Council and approved by the Executive Council.
- e) If an endowment from a donor is accepted by the University for instituting a chair the donor or his nominee may be co-opted at the discretion of the President as member of the Selection Committee for purpose of filling up of that particular position.

The qualifications for the post of teachers shall be as prescribed by University Grants Commission. The Executive Council may prescribe higher qualifications/experience as recommended by the Academic Council. The salary to the teacher shall be as prescribed by the Executive Council from time to time in pursuance of the recommendations of the University Grants Commission.
