The University has successfully completed the project on 'Reviewing and editing of the Telangana Municipalities Draft Bill, 2019' which was sanctioned by the Municipal Administration Department (MAD), Government of Telangana and submitted its Report to Government of Telangana.

Five Day Refresher Training Programme for Advocates of Telangana

NALSAR University of Law has entered into a MoU with the Telangana Advocates Welfare Trust, Department of Law, Government of Telangana to provide training for young practising advocates in the State of Telangana on May 3, 2019. The MoU was signed by Prof. (Dr.) V.Balakista Reddy, Registrar, NALSAR and Shri B. Ramanjanyulu, Secretary, Telangana Advocates Welfare Trust in the august presence of Shri.B.V.Prasad, Advocate General, Telangana, Shri V. Niranjan Rao, Secretary, Department of Law, Telangana, Shri Gandra Mohan Rao, Trust Member, V. Madhusudhan Reddy, AGP High Court, Shri. A.P. Suresh Advocate, High Court, Mr. K. Shiva Charan, Research Associate, NALSAR. The aim of this MoU is to provide training for Young practicing advocates having two to five years of experience at trial courts in Telangana State.

As part of the MoU with Telangana Advocates Welfare Trust, Department of Law, Government of Telangana, NALSAR provided rigorous and intensive five day training for three batches during the reported year. The objective of the training program was to enhance the advocacy skills which required for handling litigation matters or disputes arising before the court of law, research skills to carry out legal research on legal issues, improvisation of skill-set to render legal advisory services to resolve pre-litigation issues, specialised training in drafting legal documents, contracts/agreements and court pleadings, training to enable the trainee Advocates to get a first hand understanding and exact functioning of the Courts (from lowest to the Highest Court) in India, to improve oratory skills in English, Professional Ethics: Dos & Don'ts of legal profession and breach of professional ethics and consequences arising thereof.

The training of first batch was commenced on May 11, 2019 and the program was inaugurated by Hon'ble Shri Justice Raghvendra S. Chauhan, Chief Justice, High Court for the State of Telangana and Chancellor, NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad. NALSAR conducted training for three batches, each batch consisted of 100 advocates. The training programmes were

conducted during May 11-15, 2019; May 27-31, 2019 and June 8-12, 2019. Prof. V. Balakista Reddy, Professor of Law and Registrar co-ordinated the programmes.

5-day Training Programme for the newly elected Sarpanches of Medchal Dist. From Ferbruary 18-22, 2019

ORDER:

During the one day consultation workshop on Land administration conducted by the NALSAR University of Law on 04.03.2017 at Collectorate Suryapet, The District Collector has requested the NALSAR University of Law Technical team to work out the programme to resolve the all land issues and update the land records to the farmers in 2 villages in the district on pilot basis in next 2 months and instructed the Joint Collector to identify the villages.

The Joint Collector has identified 2 villages 1 from each revenue division viz. 1.Tuljaraopet village of Chivvemla mandal of Suryapet division and 2. Lakkavaram village of Ananthagiri mandal of Kodad

On this, The Center of Tribal and Land Rights, NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad has submitted detailed proposals to resolve all the Land problems, to update all the land records and to prepare a blue print for a low cost scalable model for land records modernization with following 6 steps.

- 1. Household survey.
- 2. Collecting Information from Land Records.
- 3. Field Verification.
- 4. Data Analysis.
- 5. Updating Land Records and Resolving Land Problem.
- 6. Land Records Kits and Land Legal Literacy.

For which they have estimated budget requirement of Rs. 6,50,000/- towards honorariums TA, DA, Formats, Legal Literacy, Documentation and Miscellaneous expenditure. And requested the District Administration for providing required budget, copies of the land records, access to Tahsil Offices and involvement of Revenue Machinery.

On examining the proposals submitted, it is hereby approved the project with an estimated cost of Rs.6,06,000/- to take up the pilot project in two villages 1.Tuljaraopet village of Chivvemla mandal of Suryapet division and 2. Lakkavaram village of Ananthagiri mandal of Kodad division for resolve all the land problems and update the land records and provide clear land titles through community driven process by the Center for Tribal & Land Rights, NALSAR University of Hyderbad with the following details of budget cost. The amount has to be met from the crucial balance funds.

PROPOSAL FOR 5-DAY TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR ADVOCATES

Advocacy in trial courts involves a number of skills and litigation strategies most of which are not taught in law schools / law departments and colleges. In today's age of specialization a fresh law graduate cannot attain competency in the desired hemisphere or take an ownership impounded with confidence to handle each case of its persona.

Any lawyer / advocate (irrespective of their stature) are expected to be aware of court procedure. He / She should be skilled enough to be able to drive the case per requirements. This normally takes years to augment proficiency in the contemporary dynamic world. One is not left to make choice of his own to specialise in the area of liking as it is. Young and enthusiastic lawyers often find it difficult to leave a mark of their own especially when an experienced lawyer in that particular field already exists. Many law graduates for this very reason either opt for high-paying corporate jobs or pursue higher studies and settle abroad.

Our newly created State of Telangana has several challenges before it. If we want to get back our share in the field of advocacy and adjudication, we have no choice but to produce better lawyers and judges. Lack of specialized training for lawyers in the State of Telangana is the biggest handicap in this regard. The State has always focused on providing specialised training for Judicial Officers but did not focus much on imparting specialised training to the lawyers fraternity who are the bridge between the courts and services seekers/public. As a matter of fact no State in India has a lawyer's academy.

By virtue of specialised training the judicial officers are in a position to discharge their works judiciously. However, same is not the case with the advocates practicing before courts of law. Lack of proper training and wrong learning in the field of law would contribute to stagnancy of civil disputes and improper adjudication of legal disputes. This in turn has led to loss of public confidence in the court of law, the entire legal fraternity and judiciary as Institution will suffer as a whole. Moreover government loses cases in the High Court because its matters are not properly defended by competent, young, energetic & trained lawyers.

Therefore seeking to fill this gap, NALSAR proposes to conduct a 5 day Refresher Training Programme to the advocates on various civil and criminal subjects including Civil Rules of Practice, Criminal Rules of Practice, CrPC, CPC, Constitution and other drafting matters.

The training programme will aim at imparting clinical / specialised training to law graduates and advocates from the practicing fraternity in enhancing their knowledge / skill set in advocacy. The proposed training is not focused on preparing the lawyers for litigation before the courts alone, but lawyers would also be specially trained in rendering advisory services on various subjects relating to Constitution, Civil and business laws, Criminal Laws, Public Policy laws, etc. It could also inspire and motivate young lawyers to do research in their chosen branch of litigation.

The proposed training programme will be targeted towards providing the advocates with a strong base where they can enhance their advocacy skills and keep themselves updated with the usage of modern technologies required in the modern era. Apart from all the above they would accomplish their hands in terms of drafting, effective argument skill, art of cross examination, relevant citation searching, etc. Most of our young lawyers have not received world class legal education. We at NALSAR feel that if we do not render our helping hand to them, we would be failing in our duty towards our State.

Objectives of the Training Programme

- To update young graduates of law in the recent advances in legal education.
- To familiarize young litigating advocates about the techniques of practicing law.
- To introduce lawyers to writing skills and legal knowledge systems
- To imparting the candidates the methods and techniques of legal research.
- To train the candidates in project formulation / writing skills / drafting skill legal documents
- To facilitate intellectual interaction with persons of legal eminence.
- To enlighten the knowledge domain of candidates on the emerging issues of legal concern and the need to codify.
- To impart leadership / corporate responsibility in administering law schools / colleges
- * To popularize gradually the lawyer's training scheme in the country
- To help NALSAR grow as the nodal centre to organize lawyers training.

About NALSAR

NALSAR as a premier university of legal expertise intends to provide a platform to the young and experienced advocates to learn the emerging issues of relevance to legal research and education. NALSAR hopes that if this initiative meets the desired objectives, its experience in (conducting lawyer's training will help give direction to the other national law colleges to help establish similar lawyer's academy by them. Over the past few years, NALSAR has established its mark as a pioneer of innovative legal education. It has already introduced and successfully administering innovative courses in air, space, defence and security disciplines and hence it is confident that the university can provide leadership in introducing and managing the lawyer's academy.

NALSAR has also been assisting the State and Central government in drafting of key legislations and through submitting reports on contemporary legal challenges faced by the society. To state in brief, NALSAR has recently submitted a Draft Andhra Pradesh Land Acquisition (Rehabilitation and Resettlement) Bill 2016 to the State of Andhra Pradesh and is currently working on drafting legislation for governing Skill Development in the State of Andhra Pradesh. Scope of Work (SoW)

The NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad, under the overall guidance of the Ministry of Shipping(MoS)/Directorate General of Shipping(DGS)/Indian Ports Association (IPA), shallinter-alia do the following tasks as a part of the Scope of Work:-

For the Act:

- 1. To examine corresponding Acts of some prominent Maritime Nations to replicate or adapt them to Indian conditions and requirements in consultation with Ministry of Shipping.
- 2. To re-visit the provisions of existing legislation Merchant Shipping Act, 1958 and also Merchant Shipping Bill 2016.
- 3. To examine the areas to be regulated but not included in the existing Act/M S Bill 2016 and to suggest provisions, which may be incorporated in the new M S Bill.
- 4. To examine the existing international conventions which have been approved by the Government but are yet to be incorporated in the MS Act (the names of the conventions i.e. Nairobi Convention, Salvage Convention, etc. be provided after consultation with DG (Shipping).
- 5. To examine the international Conventions which are not yet approved by the Government of India but which need to be incorporated into the MS Act to meet obligations under the International Conventions to which India is party or need to be a party.
- 6. To examine the extensive suggestions given by the Parliamentary Committee and comments of NITI Aayog on the draft MS Bill, 2016 and suggest changes i.e. modification, deletion or addition of new glauses in the new Bill and to formulate the draft text of such modifications, deletions and proposed new clauses with justifications.
- 7. To remove the outdated and restrictive provisions of the Act.
- 8. To suggest those aspects of the existing Act which are more procedural in nature and which may very well be covered under the rules to be framed under the new M S Act
- 9. To suggest Business process re-engineering through e-governance initiatives.
