BRIEF DESCRIPTION (MAXIMUM 500 WORDS)	<p>Cyber-crimes are rapidly expanding due to extensive use of internet and technology in the present world. Cyber-crime is a criminal activity in which computers or computer networks are used as a tool, a target, or a place of criminal activity. By extension, they may include everything ranging from an electronic cracking to a denial of service attack. The field of Cyber Forensics surfaced in response to the increasing cyber-crime in general and cyber terrorism in particular. Cyber-Crime affects, to begin with, the privacy of an individual or an organization and finally would threaten the security and integrity of the State itself.</p> <p>Varieties of evidence, collected to prove the cyber offences, will understandably be in an electronic form and it is very difficult and is also highly technical to collect, preserve, and analyze the evidence and present the same before the court of law. Cyber Forensic techniques are therefore necessary to identify, detect, collect and analyze digital evidence admissible in the court of law in order to deal with the cyber-crimes. An overall 'expertise' is needed to testify the veracity of such variations of evidence. Here comes justification for the Cyber Forensics. Needless to add, Forensics generally means the use of science and technology to establish facts in the court of law. 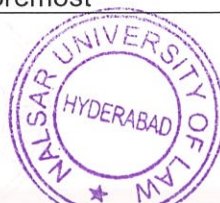
