

# Nalsar final 2017 recruitments hit 100%: 58 jobs, most at BigLaw firms • 14 to go into academia, policy, Bhutan • Only 2 opt for India courts

Nalsar Hyderabad's first out of the gate to confirm final the jobs secured by its 2017 graduating batch, scoring jobs for all 58 students who were part of the organised campus recruitments out of a total batch of 74.

Trilegal hired 4, and AZB & Partners 3.

Two students each were picked up by Khaitan & Co, P&C Legal and S&R Associates.

One job each was accepted at Finsec Law Advisors, Lakshmikumaran & Sridharan Attorneys, Nishith Desai Associates, and Zehn Legal.

On the in-house side, the RPG Group picked up 5, while ICICI Bank picked up 4 students.

# Non-RCC break-up

According to the RCC, the 16 students who did not participate in the RCC, intend to "pursue careers in academia, policy making, judicial and civil services, et cetera":

Students of the Class of 2017 have also been offered admission for further studies at prestigious universities including the University of California at Berkeley ('Boalt Hall'), the Participating Universities for the European Masters in Law and Economics program, the Faculty of Law, Oxford University, and Faculty of Law, Cambridge University, University of California at Los Angeles, Cornell University, and the London School of Economics.

The approximate current break up of future career plans of the 16 who did not participate in the RCC process, is currently the following:

- 2 students have secured LLM admissions.
- 4 are nationals of Bhutan, who will be returning to Bhutan to litigate or write public services exams there.

- 2 are planning to litigate one in Dehradun, and the other mostly in the Delhi high court but before that is currently trying to bag a judicial clerkship in the Supreme Court or Delhi high court.
- 1 will join a business.

We intend to keep updating these figures as LLM and other examination results become available, to ultimately account for what 100% of the batch is doing.



Nalsar Hyderabad's 2019 graduating batch has again found jobs for all of its 52 recruitment coordination committee (RCC) members, out of a total batch of 77.

The largest single recruiter was AZB & Partners, which hired 10, followed by Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas, which hired 7, and L&L Partners, which picked up 6.

The other large firms included Trilegal (4) and Khaitan & Co (3), and Shardul Amarchand Mangaldas (3).

One student each was picked up by Majmudar & Partners, S&R Associates and Verist Law.

One student will be joining international firm Herbert Smith Freehills on a training contract.

A total of 8 students joined corporates (led by two students each joining Edelweiss Asset Reconstruction Company, ICICI Bank, and Vedanta; GMR and HDFC Bank each picked up one).

A total of 7 had joined public sector undertakings (including two on a one-year internship with National Mineral Development Corporation). "Furthermore, we thank our alumni for extending immense support and guidance throughout the recruitment season."

The RCC was run by students Rahul Joshi, Ritika Banerjee, Sadhika Gulati, Shubham Sancheti, Shubhi Goyal and Shreejoyee Bhattacharya.

In a statement, they thanked the administration, adding: "Furthermore, we thank our alumni for extending immense support and guidance throughout the recruitment season."

The 25 other students in the batch are "intend to pursue careers in Civil Services, Judicial Services, litigation, entrepreneurship, as judicial clerks" and some have "gained an opportunity for further studies at prestigious Universities such as University of Cambridge, University of Oxford, Cornell Law School, University of Chicago Law School, University of Pennsylvania Law School and New York University", according to a statement from the RCC.

Nalsar did not share final recruitments in 2018, but in 2017, Nalsarites had scored 100% jobs for 58 RCC subscribers (out of a batch of 74).



# Nalsar's '21 batch first to reveal pandemic recruitments after long year: 100% jobs for 73 members

Nalsar Hyderabad's recruitment coordination committee (RCC) has announced the the final results for recruitments for its 73 members in an exceedingly difficult and unusual year (full stats below).

The Nalsar RCC, which only just dissolved last month (unusually late in the year), is the first of several national law universities we had contacted to share its 2021 recruitments with the world following a pandemic year that has been unpredictable so far as graduate jobs go.

A Nalsar RCC member said: "We understand that this information usually comes to you immediately following Day Zero, but given the pandemic situation, Day Zeroes across NLUs were delayed and recruitments went on for longer."

The member added: "We send this update to fill the existing information gap regarding the placements of the batch of 2021 across NLUs, so incoming students

and future aspirants might benefit from the same and be able to make better-informed decisions."

The total batch strength was 120 to 125 students, of which 73 subscribed to the RCC. According to the RCC's release:

The RCC Subscribers' Pool consisted of 73 subscribers. 6 PPOs were accepted before the RCC was constituted and 67 jobs were secured through the RCC.

Apart from the above, two subscribers secured jobs through individual endeavours as Law Clerk at the Supreme Court, and at J. Sagar Associates.

Many non-subscribers secured jobs at tier-1 firms and advocates' chambers through individual applications.

A number of 2021 graduates are also currently preparing for competitive exams like the UPSC CSE and PCS(J).

The mix of jobs is a typical one of large law firms, including even newcomers such as Anagram Partners, which hired two Nalsarites (see below).

However, Nalsar's RCC did not itemise every single job accepted by name, including a grouping of "other law firms and chambers" and "other corporate entities", which included 15 jobs in total, in order to "safeguard the exclusive relations NALSAR maintains and has established with certain entities and the interests of subsequent batches".

The RCC also said that ruing its term from October 2019 to July 2021, the RCC saw two by-elections, with old members stepping down and new members joining. The following members were part of the RCC:


