FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION

BETWEEN

ASIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (AIT), THAILAND

AND

NALSAR UNIVERSITY OF LAW (NALSAR), INDIA

1. Parties

The parties to this LETTER OF INTENT are:

- Asian Institute of Technology, Bangkok, Thailand, hereafter referred to as "AIT"
- NALSAR University of Law, India, hereafter referred to as "NALSAR"

The Asian Institute of Technology (AIT) is an international institute of higher learning. It is Asia's pioneer institution, established in 1959 to help meet the region's growing needs for advanced education in engineering, science, technology and management, research, and capacity building. AIT's mission is to develop highly qualified and committed professionals who will lead the region's sustainable development and integration into the global economy. AIT is based in Thailand.

The National Academy of Legal Studies and Research (NALSAR) is a public law school and a National Law University in Shamirpet, Hyderabad, Telangana, India. It is considered one of India's best law schools. It is among the first universities to offer a five-year integrated undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctorate law degree. Besides law, it offers a five-year integrated management degree and an MBA from its Department of Management Studies. The university is known for its highly competitive admissions and has an acceptance rate of 0.132 %. It has an intake of around 132 students selected from a pool of around 100,000 students in its undergraduate law program.

2. Purpose

2.1 The broad objectives of this LETTER OF INTENT are to promote cultural, educational, and scholarly exchange, collaboration, and technical interchange between the parties involved as educational partners.

2.2 Upon the mutual consent of the parties, including the relevant academic management within the universities, subject to the availability of funds, collaboration may be carried out in, but not necessarily limited to, the following activities:

- Joint organization of international student mobility, internships, and immersion programs
- Short-term faculty and staff development programs and visits
- Joint organization of conferences, seminars and research support
- Special Scholarships for meritorious faculties/staff/students of NALSAR to study postgraduate at AIT
- Initiate short term joint community development programs.

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- 2.3 Addenda to this document may identify specific programs or projects, which will be undertaken within this overall LETTER OF INTENT, and the details of respective management. Further Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) shall be developed for specific agreements based on the mutually agreed upon objectives and outcomes, at any time. Professor Srikrishna Deva Rao, Vice Chancellor of NALSAR is fully instrumentality authorized to sign the MOUs on behalf of the NALSAR and Prof. Kazuo Yamamoto, President of AIT is fully instrumentality authorized to sign the MOUs on behalf of the AIT.
- 2.4 The purpose of this LETTER OF INTENT is to outline an academic and management framework between the two parties, designed to promote internationalization at both institutions. The parties do not intend to be legally bound to each other, and this LETTER OF INTENT does not impose legal obligations on either party.

3. Joint Managers, Administrative Officers, and Working Parties

- 3.1 Prof. PSS Rao from NALSAR while Prof. Nitin Kumar Tripathi from AIT are designated to be as Joint Managers in the execution of this LETTER OF INTENT.
- 3.2 The Joint Managers may appoint Administrative Officers or Working Parties to manage the details of particular activities, curriculum or program development, as specified in the addenda to this LETTER OF INTENT.

4. Duration of LETTER OF INTENT

- 4.1 This LETTER OF INTENT will be effective upon signature by each University Joint Managers for a period of two (2) years, at which time it will be reviewed for possible renewal for another five-year period.
- 4.2 The Joint Managers may propose a mutually agreed upon modification to activities or arrangements under this LETTER OF INTENT. However, all modifications are subject to express written ratification by each Managers (or an expressly designated delegate) prior to the implementation of the modification.

5. Contact Persons

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This Letter of Intent (LOI) is prepared in two identical copies. Each Party holds one original copy, duly signed by the Executive Director for Special Degree Programs of AIT and the Prof. P Srinivas Subbarao of NALSAR.
